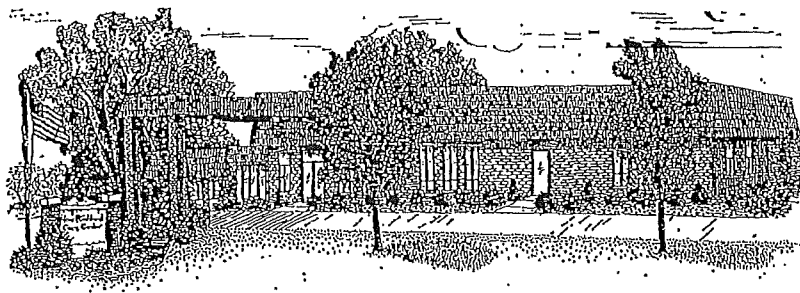

#### **From the Desk of the Administrator!**

July 4<sup>th</sup> is always a special day for me as we as a nation celebrate our independence from British rule and reminisce on how special our nation is with its abundance of wealth, freedom and our magnificent quality of life.

With this in mind, we strive to provide each resident with the highest quality of life we can offer. As many of you know, reimbursements went up on January 1<sup>st</sup> of this year and some were wondering how we plan on using the increase to improve the life of our residents. Some of the improvements that have been approved at this time are:

-New washers and dryers, the current ones are about 20 years old and need constant repairs. The new washers and dryers are more energy efficient and gentler on clothes.

-We have replaced most of the TVs in each resident room with new 32 inch flat screen TVs. We should have all of them replaced by the end of July.

-We are replacing all the bedspreads, curtains and privacy curtains in each resident room. We have ordered bedspreads, curtains and privacy curtains for 1 room to see how everything looks. If it looks as good as we picture, we will order enough for all the rooms. We have learned that it takes 10-12 weeks for an order to come in as each curtain and bedspread is made to order. These items are a commercial grade which means they will stand up to years of use.

In addition, we are looking at replacing the sinks in the resident bathrooms. These have been in the building since we opened in 1975.

We have plans to continue improving and upgrading our facility over the next few years. As the months go by, you will begin to see a noticeable difference in our center. This summer we are working on the outside of the building, getting the parking lot chipped sealed and painting areas outside of the building as needed.

I feel blessed to be the Administrator of such a wonderful Care Center where the City and Advisory Board put the needs of the center and its employees above profits.

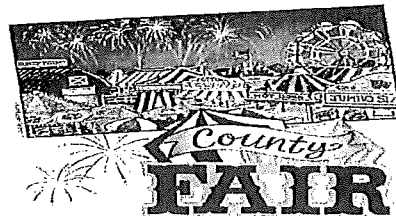

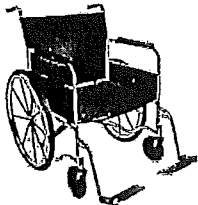

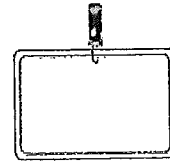
## “Meeting Our NRCC Family”
