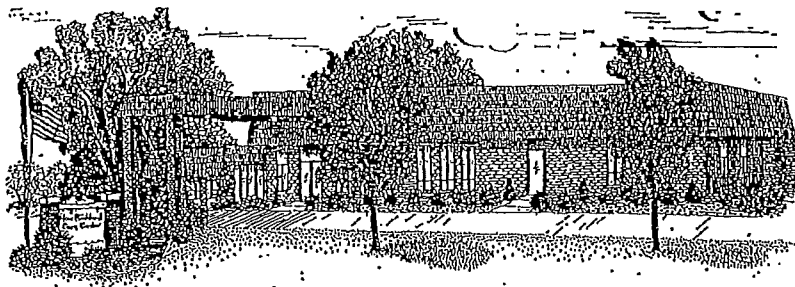

From the Desk of the Administrator!

May you all have a wonderful Labor Day Weekend.

During the past few months I have been asked about the status of improvements around the building that were mentioned in earlier newsletters. As a result I have decided to list what we plan on doing and where we are in the process.

- Concerning installing 32 inch TVs in each resident room, we have completed this task for all resident rooms that needed them.
- Regarding new curtains, privacy curtains, and bedspreads. We are waiting for the window curtains that are on back order and will not be in until September 9th. Once everything is installed in room 210 and we know for certain they enhance the room the way we envision, we will order enough for the entire facility. With a cost of over \$20,000 we want to be certain that we are getting the product we expect and that the residents will enjoy them. Once new curtains and bedspreads for all the rooms have been ordered, we will begin painting the resident's bathroom and an accent wall similar to the room 210.
- We have purchased and installed new washers and dryers for a cost of about \$28,000.
- We have purchased and installed a new convention oven for a cost of about \$4,000.
- We purchased a new BBQ Grill.
- We continue to paint the outside of the building; so far we finished painting the gazebo and benches. We still plan on painting the iron fence, other woodwork in addition to power washing and paint above and below the windows as time permits until winter sets in. What we do not finish this year, we will work on next summer.

Over the course of 12-18 months, you will see a noticeable improvement of the facility. Please let me know if you have any questions.

*If you bring in items, please let us know so we can mark them.





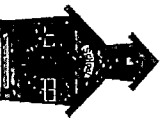
